Job Task Analysis (JTA) Task Force	Revision of the IR Competency Framework and administration of a survey to a representative sample of investor relations professionals. Multiple openings available. Approx. 10 hours during Q1-Q2, 2023. 10 Approved PDUs.
Investor Relations Charter (IRC) [®]	The Investor Relations Charter (IRC [®]) Certification Council adopts policies and procedures that govern the IRC scheme. The Examination Development Committee is responsible for constructing IRC examination forms and building the item bank to meet psychometric guidelines and test specifications. Two openings available. 4-6 hours annually. 3 Approved PDUs.
Micro Volunteer Opportunities	Project-based on short term opportunities are available throughout the year.
