## Terms and Conditions/Waiver and Release of Liability

NIRI has taken preventative measures to reduce the spread of communicable disease including but not limited to COVID-19 at the 2022 NIRI Annual Conference.

All event participants are required to abide by all applicable COVID-19-related requirements, advisories, policies, procedures, and protocols of NIRI, the Omni Boston Seaport, as well as the <u>World Health Organization</u> (WHO), the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u> (CDC), the State of Massachusetts, the City of Boston, and any other governmental authority for the duration of their stay.
